CPE Intern Program – Academic-Year Extended 2026-2027 Unit

Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) is an interfaith professional education for spiritual care and ministry with emphasis on learning from your direct clinical/pastoral care and group experiences. Out of an intense involvement with persons in need, and the feedback from peers and the educator, students develop an increased awareness of themselves as persons and of the needs of those whom they serve. From theological/spiritual reflection on specific human situations, they gain a deeper understanding of their ministry and helping roles.

Weekly seminars with peers and individual supervision focus on the self-directed adult learners' particular learning goals and needs. CPE equips students with interpersonal, spiritual care and counseling, and crisis ministry skills that are crucial for ministry in healthcare, parish, community, and other settings. We welcome persons of all faith traditions from a variety of ministry and helping roles who are seeking to develop their knowledge and skills as spiritual care providers.

Weekly Educational Seminar Schedule:

Part-time, flexible schedule that follows an academic calendar schedule.

Class meets for five hours weekly for group seminars (day to be determined), eight hours per week of clinical visitation, plus overnight and weekend on-call responsibilities.

*Participants should also plan for **additional** time for reading, writing case studies, theological & personal reflection, self-care, and emotional integration.*

Deposit/Tuition/Fees:

\$175 nonrefundable deposit is due upon acceptance. This amount is applied to the total \$550 tuition. There is an additional \$39 fee to process a required background check
