This is the Standard FM track that all residents will complete during their 3 year residency at IU Ball Memorial. Our calendar consists of 13 4-week blocks. Electives may be 2 or 4 weeks depending on the elective.

Key to Abbreviations above:

WARDS = Inpatient Service (on a dedicated FM team)

EM = Emergency Medicine

PEDS EM = Pediatric Urgent Care and Emergency Medicine

CARDS = Cardiology

AMB = Outpatient FM Time in the Family Medicine Residency Center with emphasis on clinic efficiency & coding

MSK I/II = Musculoskeletal Blocks that encompass Sports Medicine, Orthopedics, Rheumatology and Physical Therapy

PROC = Procedure Block at the start of 2nd year taught by the Directors and other faculty. It encompasses all FM procedures including colposcopy, colonoscopy, vasectomy, skin lesion removal, toenail removal, hemorrhoid banding, endometrial biopsy, IUD, Nexplanon, Casting/Splinting, Joint Injections, Ultrasound and more)

MED SELECT = Medical Selective rotations that include Pulmonology, Gastroenterology, Nephrology, Neurology, Infectious Disease, Allergy/Immunology, Rheumatology, Endocrinology

SURG SUB = Surgical Subspecialty Block that includes experiences in ENT, Ophthalmology, Urology and Podiatry.

GERI = Geriatrics Block that includes time in both inpatient and outpatient as well as in the Nursing Home

ELECTIVE = RESIDENT MAY CHOOSE FROM AN ELECTIVE DEVELOPED PREVIOUSLY OR CREATE THEIR OWN WITH THE GUIDANCE OF THEIR ADVISOR
