



## CELEBRATING PATIENTS' LAST CANCER TREATMENT

Indiana University Health Bedford Hospital began a new program for their patients in Cancer Services who have completed their treatments. In the summer of 2016, a few IU Health Bedford team members and volunteers had the idea of making their patients' last treatments a celebration. The team contacted a local bakery about donating a cake for each patient who completes a treatment and purchased a specially made plaque and bell to ring on their last day of treatment.

After months of treatment, one patient underwent her last cancer treatment at IU Health Bedford Hospital Cancer Services. Consumed with emotion, she made her way to ring the bell of completion and celebrate with her cake presented to her by the Cancer Services team.

One month prior to her completion, she had participated in the Look Good, Feel Better program hosted at IU Health Bedford Hospital. The program provides specialized support and guidance including advice on applying makeup and choosing hair accessories or alternatives.

### FOR HEALTH PROFESSIONS EDUCATION


We spent a total of \$229,248 on education and training for our healthcare professionals.
