## Maternal and Infant Health

**78** mothers learned safe sleep practices at Fresh Start Recovery Center.



**45** outpatient breastfeeding consultations provided by IU Health.



**74%** of infants born at the IU Health Maternity Center started out breastfeeding.



## Behavioral Health

**98%** of students promoted inclusion and/or reduced exclusionary behaviors during play with Playworks.



**1,390** teens served by LifeSmart Youth's Communicating with And Respecting Each other (CARE) program.



**100%** of clients and families could access free support groups at Coburn Place.



## Obesity and Access to Healthy Food

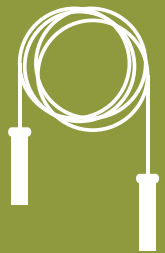
**1,098** children and youth learned the 5-2-1-0 healthy lifestyle message with Jump IN for Healthy Kids.
