Overview: *Electronic interfaced ordering in Cerner will replace manual ordering and resulting.*

On April 22nd, 2020 the IU Health Pathology Laboratory will add testing to the list of available interfaced tests.

These tests were previously only available by ordering a Miscellaneous Test request. The list contains testing shipped to **ARUP, Athena, Quest and Viracor Laboratories**. The anticipated outcomes will be primarily a patient safety outcome with electronic ordering and resulting decreasing the chances of incorrect or improper orders and inaccurate results. Other anticipated outcomes will be improved turnaround time for results and a smoother ordering/report entry process resulting in less ordering confusion.

Updates will be made to the Lab Test Directory as the conversions take place.

Please view test requirements on the Laboratory Test Directory. Ordering will remain the same and providers should not notice a difference in the ordering process.

Additional Tests available include:

- Allergen Bovine Serum Albumin
- Allergen Gum Arabic
- Allergen Gum Tragacanth
- Legionella Species PCR, Qualitative
- F5HD1/Southern Blot
- Ganglionic AChR Antibody
