**Overview:** *Electronic interfaced ordering in Cerner for Emory Genetics testing will replace manual ordering and resulting.*

## Topic

On February 6th, the IU Health Pathology Laboratory will launch a new reference lab interface within Cerner’s Reference Lab Network. Emory Genetic Laboratory (EGL) testing will convert from Miscellaneous Sendout orders to electronic ordering and interfaced results via the new interface.

The anticipated outcomes will be primarily a patient safety outcome with electronic ordering and resulting decreasing the chances of incorrect or improper orders and inaccurate results. Other anticipated outcomes will be improved turnaround time for results and a smoother ordering/report entry process resulting in less ordering confusion. The new result will include a PDF copy in Powerchart of the original report.
