On June 15, 2021, the IU Health Pathology Laboratory will add orderable testing to the Prevention Genetics RLN interface. Please include an appropriate email address for result notification and any appropriate clinical notes should accompany the requisition.

The anticipated outcomes will be primarily one of patient safety with electronic ordering and resulting decreasing the chances of incorrect or improper orders and inaccurate results. Other anticipated outcomes will be improved turnaround time for results and a smoother ordering/report entry process resulting in less ordering confusion.
