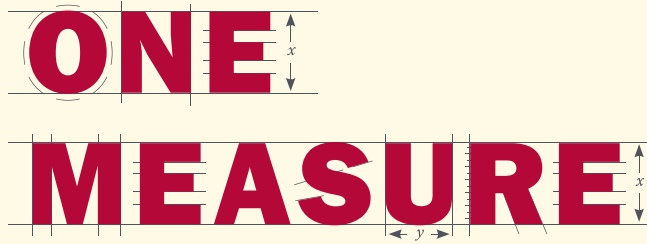


2018 COMMUNITY BENEFIT REPORT HIGHLIGHT
