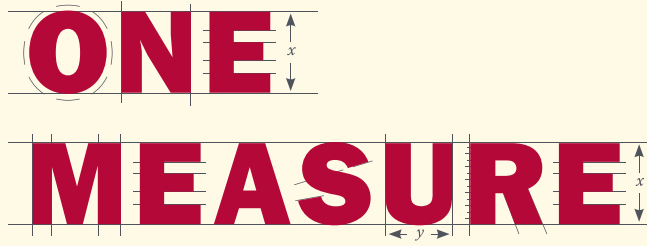


2018 COMMUNITY BENEFIT REPORT HIGHLIGHT

2018 DAY OF SERVICE – TIPTON CITY PARK AND COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS

For its 2018 Day of Service, IU Health Tipton Hospital chose to foster healthy living in the Tipton area by making improvements to the Tipton City Park and Tipton County Fairgrounds. Team members helped purchase and assemble five picnic tables for the park, replacing some worn tables and offering families and other groups more opportunity to gather. Volunteers also painted footbridge railings and installed brightly painted fence pickets in a toddler play area.

At the fairgrounds, IU Health Tipton Hospital team members planted 13 trees, replacing others lost to damage or disease. Like the park, the fairgrounds are a popular gathering place for friends and family, and the new trees promise to offer Tipton residents some welcome shade for years to come.
