Download and first time registration

Step 1

Go to the App Store* and download IU Health Virtual Visits.

Note: Wi-Fi connection is recommended for download.

*Also available for Android devices on the Google Play store.



Step 2

Choose **Sign Up** on the bottom right corner.



Step 3

Enter all of the required demographic information and select **Continue**.




Connecting to a virtual visit from your smart device

Select the calendar icon at the bottom of the screen.




Step 4

Your appointment with your provider will be listed at the top of the screen. Select the appointment to begin your visit.




Step 5
